VPK students at MGRI receive instruction at no additional cost during the academic hours of **8:30am-11:30am**. VPK Wrap-around tuition applies for families interested in enrolling the student for a full day or extended day schedule.

OBLIGATIONS & PAYMENT INFORMATION

Enrollment fees: All enrollment fees are <u>non-refundable</u> for new and returning families. For new families, a registration fee and material fee are due upon acceptance of student to formally secure enrollment. Returning families must pay the annual student material fee by <u>June 1st</u> to secure enrollment for the new school year.

Payment of Tuition: MGRI is partnered with FACTS Management Company to manage and collect tuition payments. Tuition is due on the 1st of each month and will be automatically deducted from the account on file. Automatic debits from a checking or savings account have no processing fees. Automatic debit from a credit or debit card will have a 2.95% processing fee. Families will have three payment plan options: payment in full (5% discount applied), semi-annual (2% discount applied), and monthly. There is a one-time FACTS enrollment fee for families based on the payment plan selected. Fees are listed below. Families should contact <u>accounting@montessoriglobalri.com</u> three (3) business days prior



to a payment due date to make any adjustments to the automatic withdrawal. A valid debit or credit card is required to be on file with MGRI.

Payment Plan Options:

- Payment in Full:
 - Total tuition balance by July 1st (8% discount). One-time \$25 FACTS fee.
 - \circ Total tuition balance by August 1st (5% discount). One-time \$25 FACTS fee.
- **Semi-annual:** Two equal payments of the total tuition balance (2% discount) due on August 1st and January 1st of the school year. One-time \$25 FACTS fee.
- Monthly Payments: 10 or 12 equal monthly payments of the total tuition balance due on the 1st of every month depending on the elected program. The academic year for the 10-month program is August May, and for the 12-month program it is August July. One-time \$55 FACTS fee.

Late Payment Fee: A \$50 late fee will apply to invoices if payment is not received by FACTS Management Company's second attempt to collect tuition payment. Accounts will be sent to a thirdparty collection agency after 60 days of no payment or establishment of a payment plan. MGRI reserves the right to suspend a student until a past due account is current.

Sibling Discounts: A tuition discount of 10% will apply to the oldest sibling and a 5% discount will apply to each additional sibling.

Step Up for Students: Scholarship award information is due to MGRI by July 1st. Families are financially responsible for all tuition not covered by their scholarship award. If a student's total award amount is greater than their annual tuition, the difference may be applied to materials, uniforms, or school events. Any difference applied to material fees will be provided in the form of a refund once MGRI receives the first quarterly distribution of scholarship funds as payment for material fees are due prior to scholarship award amounts being announced.

Tuition Obligations: Once a parent submits an executed enrollment contract and the required fees, a student will be enrolled for the entire 10- or 12-month academic year (or remainder of the academic year if applicable). Parent understands that the overheard expenses of the school do not diminish with the departure of some students during the course of the academic year and agrees that it is impossible for the school to determine at the time of the parent's execution of their enrollment contract the damage and loss to the school that would occur due to the later cancellation/withdrawal of students who have enrolled. This means that parent becomes liable for the entire academic year's tuition and fees as liquidated damages (and not penalty) even if the student is withdrawn, absent, or is involuntarily



separated from School; UNLESS, a parent terminates their contract in strict accordance with the termination procedures outlined below. If Student is withdrawn, absent, or involuntarily separated, for any reason, including without limitation, change of residence, health, withdrawal, or expulsion, not in accordance with the procedure, there will be no refund or reduction of fees or tuition, and any unpaid balance may become immediately due and payable. If the Student is a scholarship recipient, and the funding does not meet 100% of the tuition and fees obligations, the customer is liable for the differential. The customer is responsible for all legal and collection fees if such actions are necessary by MGRI to obtain outstanding tuition. MGRI reserves the right to change tuition, fees, and program hours. Note that payments are eligible for Federal Child and Dependent Care Tax Credit (CDCTC). Federal tax ID #: 45-4920620.

Termination Procedures: Parents may terminate their enrollment contract by paying a contract termination fee of \$950 and submitting a 30-day WRITTEN Termination Notice to administration. The termination notice must be (a) be dated (b) state the student's name, (c) provide the termination date (student's last day) and reason for the termination of the Contract; and (d) be RECEIVED by Admissions no later than 30 days before the student's last day of attendance. Parents must pay contract termination fee in full prior to termination date. Tuition for the student's last month will be due accordingly. If such termination notice, and fee, is timely received, parents will be relieved of all tuition paid and other payments and fees that would have come due after the termination date. Even if an enrollment contract terminated pursuant to the terms of this Paragraph, parents understand that the school will not refund any portion of the student's tuition. This termination procedure applies to ALL student enrollment contracts regardless of student receiving scholarship assistance or Early Learning Coalition funding.
